



KEERAPAT INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

KEERAPAT INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL (KPIS) awards academic scholarships to eligible KPIS students based on the student's admission application. Applicants can avail of this scholarship once for the entire Elementary level and Secondary level. The academic scholarship is only granted once in the entire Elementary level, Middle School level and High school level, which means that when the academic scholarship is revoked or not renewed, should the scholarship be revoked or cancelled for any cause, the recipient can only re-apply for academic scholarship grants after completing current level of study (i.e. Elementary level to Middle School level). When one level is completed, the grantee needs to apply for the next level.

Selection is done by the Committee on Academic Scholarship and eligibility is based upon a student's academic credentials, standardized tests performance, class rank, school activities involvement and overall character.

Academic scholarships are awarded to KPIS students in the span of their Elementary education period, Middle School and High School education period. Once granted, the recipients must comply with all the scholarship requirements to be eligible for renewal of scholarship annually.

Students who receive a KPIS funded academic scholarships must maintain a minimum average academic grade requirement for the whole academic year (2 semesters) as follows:

Table 1
Minimum Average Academic Grade Requirement

Division	Academic Grade Requirement
Elementary : Lower (Grade 1 – 3)	Average G with no grades lower than S
: Upper (Grade 4 – 6)	3.0 GPA with no grades lower than C-
Secondary : Middle School (Grades 7 & 8)	3.0 GPA with no grades lower than C-
: High School (Grade 9 – 11)	3.0 GPA with no grades lower than C-

Note: Administrative grades of Incomplete (Inc) or (I), no credit due to Absences, etc. are considered grades lower than the minimum grade requirement.

Students have two (2) semesters to meet the minimum academic grade requirements for scholarship. If the recipient's minimum average grade or GPA falls below the minimum average academic grade required, the KPIS funded Sports Scholarship will not be renewed and his/her name will automatically be removed from the scholarship list. Likewise, any misconduct on the part of the recipient will automatically cancel the Sports Scholarship grant.

All applicants must submit the following requirements:

1. Official transcript of records from the former school sealed and signed by the school Registrar, with computed GPA.
2. Certification of Good Moral Character from the Principal and Guidance Counselor of the former school.
3. Academic Merit (Section 2): Attach a list of the academic achievements at senior secondary level if applicable and/or education history including subject or academic merit awards, including any involvement in National or State competitions (i.e. Math Minds, Debating etc).
4. Community Service (Section 3): Provide a brief profile (paragraph), on any areas of community work/activities you have been involved with. Examples may include; volunteer work or membership of clubs.
5. Personal Statement (Section 4): Provide in no more than 200 words the following statement including:
 1. Describe how the KPIS Academic Scholarship will help you make a difference in the school community
 2. Identify one significant challenge facing students today and how to address this challenge.
6. Completed application form, signed by the student and parents concerned.
7. Medical Examination Certification from a first class physician or an official medical establishment.

After receipt and evaluation of the aforementioned requirements, practical examination and/or audition and interview will be scheduled to prospective applicants.

Students applying for KPIS scholarship awards must have above average English communication skills both oral and written and must have passing mark in the KPIS Scholarship Qualifying Examination. He/She must be healthy and physically fit to undertake the rigor of the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Applicants who satisfactorily passed the examination/audition and interview will be granted the Academic Scholarship and will be assigned to the KPIS Academic Teams. They are required to attend all practices and competitions.

The committee on Academic Scholarship shall be composed of **the Executive Director of Academics, Head of Department, and Counselor** all appointed by the President. It shall organize, prepare and administer all the requirements to qualify applicants for scholarship such as application forms, evaluation of documents submitted, preparation and administration of examination questionnaire and interview schedules. Further, it shall be empowered to deliberate on all matters concerning the Academic Scholarship and shall recommend to the School Board the list of prospective Academic Scholars for confirmation.
